Airbags were designed to inflate rapidly in an accident. **They** were designed to stop an average adult male who doesn't bother to fasten his seat belt from smashing into the car front glass. Therefore, they inflate at about 200 miles per hour. Airbags can be useful, but you must know and account for the dangers.

And of course, all passengers should use their seat belts. The day will come when vehicles are equipped with "smart airbags" that automatically adjust their force to size and weight of a passenger.
