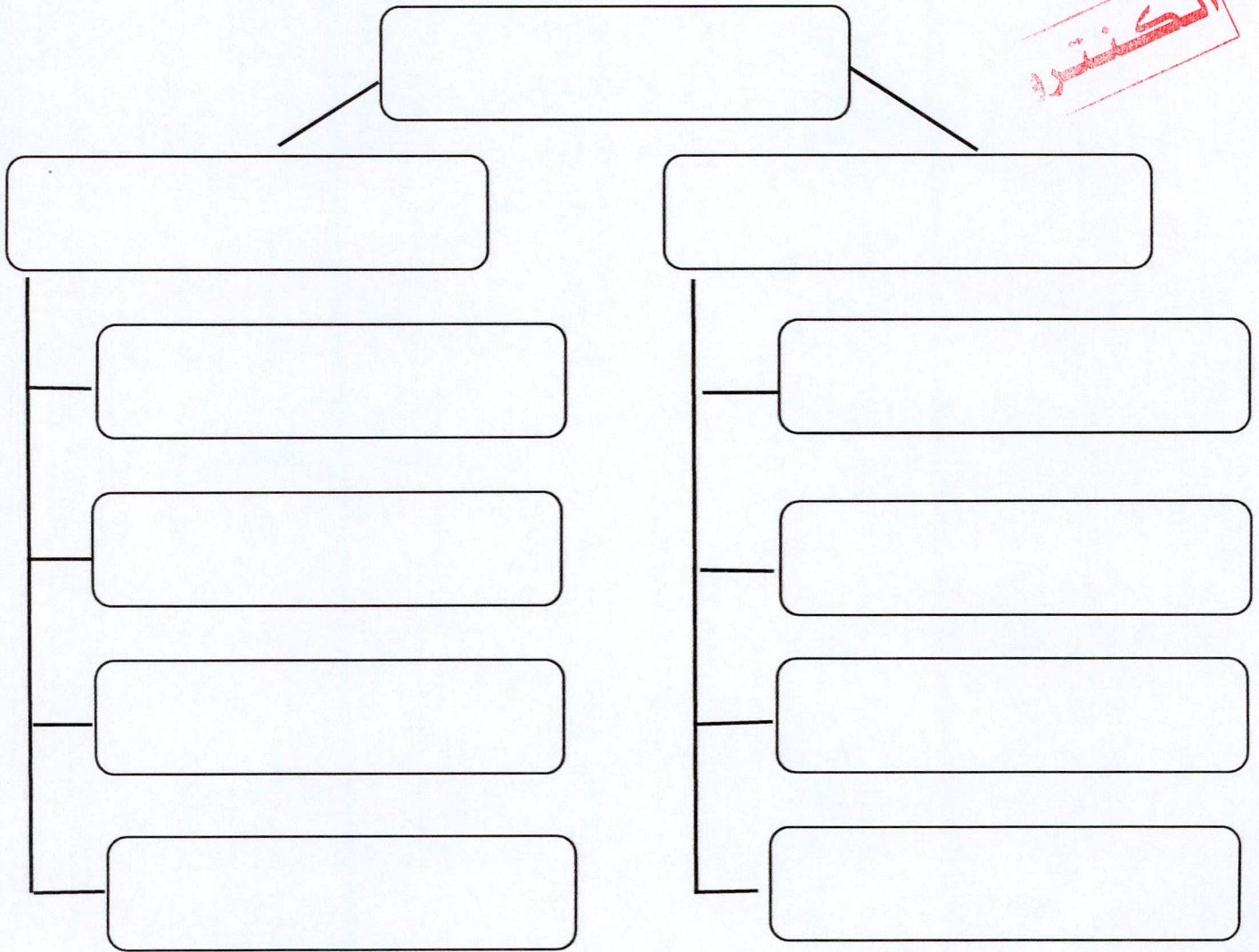

Read the following passage carefully, then answer the questions below:

Deserts cover more than one-fifth of the Earth's land area, and they are found on every continent. Despite the common idea that deserts are hot, there are cold deserts as well. The largest hot desert in the world, northern Africa's Sahara, reaches temperatures of up to 122 degrees Fahrenheit during the day. But some deserts are always cold, like the Gobi desert in Asia and the polar deserts of the Antarctic and Arctic, which are the world's largest.

Deserts are the driest habitats on Earth, which can make it difficult for plants and animals to survive. While it can rain in a desert, **they** get less than ten inches of rainwater per year. With such dry land, temperatures can get over 100 degrees Fahrenheit.

Deserts are full of plants and animals that don't need much water to live. Some plants can wait years for rain. A cactus can hold water in its stem, so it does not need rain very often.

Other plants have very long roots that can get to water stored deep underground. Many animals that live in desert habitats come out only when the hot sun has gone down. Other animals hide underground or among large rocks to stay in the shade. Animals can get water from eating seeds, or from eating other animals. The dry conditions of a desert habitat can be hard to live in, however, plants and animals have **adapted** to their surroundings to create ways to survive.
