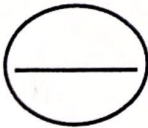

Do you have an iPad, iPhone or a Mac computer? Did you know that Steve Jobs made the company – Apple – that created these things. He was born on February 24, 1955, in California. When he was a boy, he had a special hobby; he liked to take televisions apart and put them back together again.

Steve Jobs was a very good student at school. He graduated from high school at the age of 17. Then he began his studies in Reed College, in Portland, but he dropped out after six months. Deciding to quit university was not easy at all. It was difficult, but as Jobs later said, "I had no idea what I wanted to do with my life." Two years later in 1974, he travelled to India. There, he met a friend who became later his top employee in Apple.

After Steve Jobs returned to the United States, he found a job as a videogame designer at a company called Atari. After two years, in 1976, when he was only twenty-one, he created his own company – Apple Computer – with his friend, Steve Wozniak. Steve Jobs later got married in 1991 and had four children. Unfortunately, doctors discovered that he had cancer in 2003 and he died in 2011.
