Nowadays, everybody needs to be aware of the importance of protecting the environment. There are many original ways of recycling the things that other people throw away. Creative designers in South Africa are making new and interesting objects from rubbish, and helping local communities at the same time.



Young children of the country collect empty glass bottles from the local community and sell them to designers in the south who give them new life as necklaces or handles for knives, forks and spoons. The bottles are first broken into small pieces of glass, then crushed into powder and heated to a high temperature in an oven. It is dangerous work and it takes a long time. The glass is then melted by heat and shaped into beads, which are used to create necklaces and other objects.

Some other designers recycle old skateboards and turn them into sunglasses of different colours. **They** say: "Throwing away old skateboards is a huge waste. Top-quality boards are made of wood from trees, which take years to grow. It is very bad to throw these boards away each year. The wood is very **light** and so is perfect for frames for sunglasses."

Many large companies in Japan not only create new and original pieces from unwanted everyday items, but they also create jobs for many local people. These people work together in co-operatives, and so they all share the profits.
