A volcano is a mountain where hot melted rocks come through the big hole on the top of it. The hot melted rocks deep below Earth's ground is called magma and it rises up to the big hole on the top. If the magma reaches the ground, it flows out of the volcano when it erupts or happens.

Scientists have classified volcanoes into three main types: active, dormant (sleeping), and extinct (no longer found). With an active volcano, there is the possibility the volcano will erupt. A dormant volcano is a volcano that has not erupted in a very long time but there is a possibility that it may **erupt** sometime in the future. The third type, the extinct volcano, is one that erupted thousands of years ago and there is no possibility of another eruption.


The Earth has approximately 1500 volcanoes which are considered active, and about 100 of those are under the oceans. Erupting volcanoes have been known to burn out whole forests, cause floods and rock falls. However, volcanoes that erupt can also make new islands once the hot magma cools off, especially **those** near the shores, rivers or below the ocean's surface.

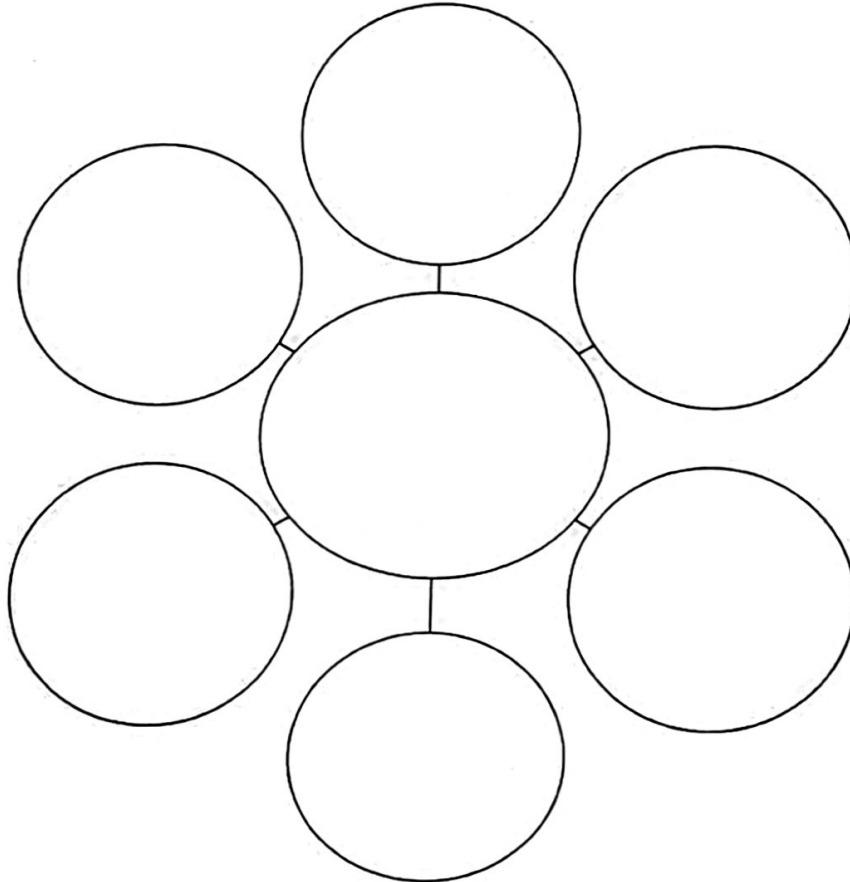

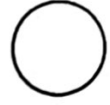
