John loved to read. As a teenager, he spent many hours reading books at the Oakland, California, public library. He joined college at the University of California at Berkeley, but he stayed for only six months. He thought Berkeley was <u>dull</u> and wanted to do something exciting.



While living in different cities, John wrote stories about working people. He knew and understood <u>their</u> problems. He worked as a sailor, farmer, factory worker and a miner, to name just a few of his many jobs.

John grew up near the waterfront in Oakland. When he was fifteen years old, he bought a small sailboat called a sloop. Later he sailed to Japan on a schooner, which is a much larger sailing boat.


