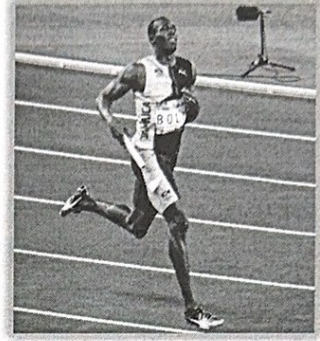

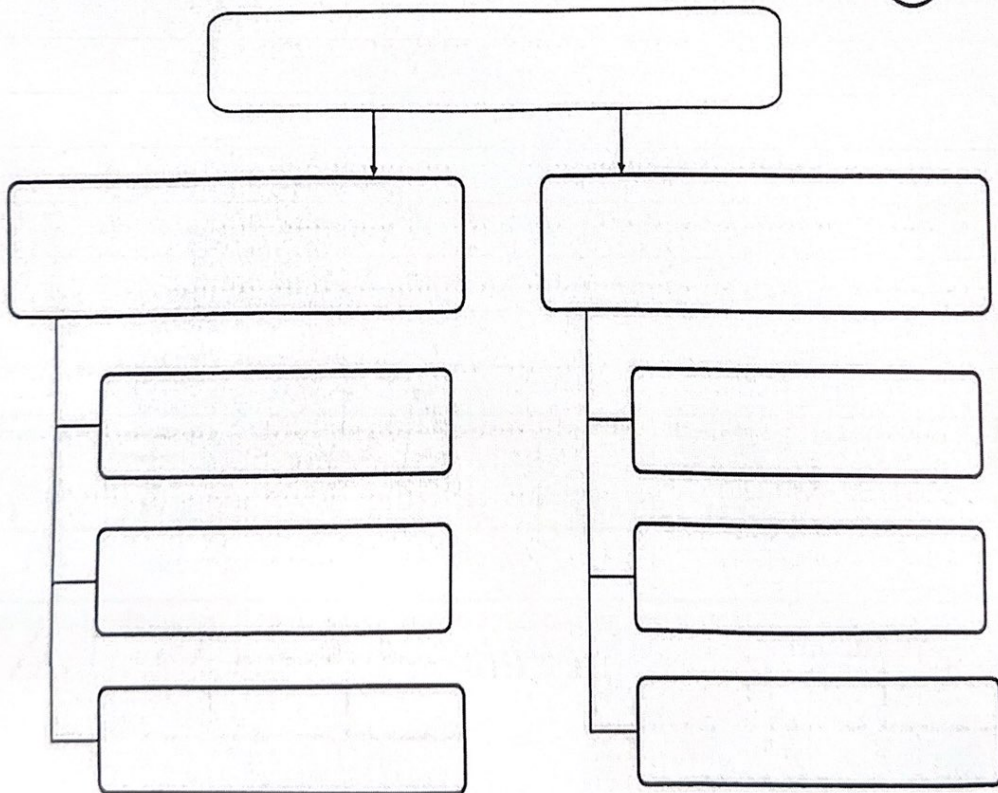
“Energy is very important for everything nowadays.”
