It is important in our daily life to take simple steps to save energy and be kind to the environment. Making small changes in our daily habits can make a big difference in saving energy at home. One easy action is turning off lights and electronic devices when we're not using them. This simple step can reduce the amount of electricity we use and make us pay less money. It is also a good idea to use energy-saving LED bulbs instead of usual light bulbs. LED bulbs use less energy and last longer, so **they** are a great choice for lighting up our homes while saving money.

When we are buying new household appliances, like fridges or washing machines, we should look for the Energy Star label. This label tells us that the product meets quality rules for being energy saving. Choosing appliances with the Energy Star label not only helps the environment but also saves our money.

Another way to save energy is by making sure that our homes are well-protected. This means using materials that keep the heat or cool air inside our homes. By sealing gaps in doors and windows, we can stop both the warm air or the cool air from getting in or out during winter or summer. This helps us use <u>less</u> energy for heating or air conditioning.


