

B) Reading Comprehension (16 Marks) Read the following passage, then answer the questions that follow.

Have you got an exercise app on your phone? Many apps allow you to share your data with friends and even virtual friends around the world. For example, on many running apps, you can 'follow' other people in your area and see which runs they do and how fast they do them. Is it possible that our workouts will be influenced by our friends?

A recent study looked at data from 1.1 million runners from all over the world, and how often, far and fast they ran on every run over a period of five years. It found that, generally, people using running apps run more often if their friends, real or virtual, run a lot. The researchers thought there was a possibility that runners might not influence their friends, but that perhaps people looked for virtual friends who ran in similar conditions to them. So, they decided to check this by looking at the weather. If the weather is bad, people are generally less likely to go for a run on that day. However, they found that even when the weather was bad, surprisingly, people were more likely to run if their friends ran too.

The study shows how social media groups are important when it comes to exercising. So, if you find it difficult to get off the sofa and work out, maybe you need to find some <u>active</u> friends who could give you that push!


