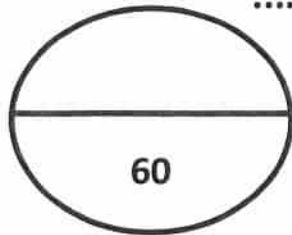

Before the telephone was invented, people relied on sending telegrams or writing letters to communicate with each other, which took a long time. But Alexander Graham Bell had a vision of a device that could **transmit** sound over a long distance, allowing people to talk to each other in real time.

Bell worked tirelessly in his laboratory, experimenting with different materials and designs. Finally, on March 10, 1876, he was successful. He made the first ever phone call to his assistant, Thomas Watson, who was in another room. Bell said, "Mr. Watson, come here! I want to see you." And Watson was able to hear him clearly through the telephone. They were both amazed and excited by this incredible achievement.

Soon people from all over the world were interested in the telephone. Bell started the Bell Telephone Company to make and sell telephones. In the beginning, telephones were big with a separate earpiece and mouthpiece. They had to be connected with wires, and people had to make a handle turn to call someone. But as technology advanced, telephones became small, portable, and wireless. Today, we have smartphones **that** can do so much more than just make phone calls!
