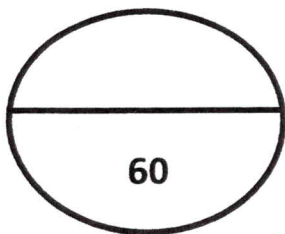

But their body clocks make it hard for them to go to bed before 11:00 p.m., so the best time for them to wake up is around 8:00 a.m.

The head teacher decided to try an experiment. He changed the start time for lessons to 9:00 a.m. The school still opened at 8:00 a.m. and teachers used the extra hour for preparing lessons.


