Tower Bridge is a famous bridge located in London, England. It is one of the most **iconic** and well-known landmarks in the city. Tower Bridge got its name because it is located near the Tower of London. The bridge was built over 125 years ago and it took eight years to complete.

Tower Bridge is not an ordinary bridge. It is a drawbridge, which means it can open and close to let boats pass through. This is because the bridge was built over the River Thames, which is an important waterway. When a big boat needs to pass, the two arms of the bridge lift up in the air, creating a space for the boat to go under.

The bridge is made of steel and it is over 800 feet long. It has two tall towers, and that is where it gets its name from. The towers are connected by a walkway, which is open to visitors. Inside the towers of Tower Bridge, there is a special exhibition called the Tower Bridge Exhibition. It tells the story of how the bridge was built and how **it** works. You can learn about the people who worked on the bridge and the technology they used.

So, if you ever visit London, make sure to visit Tower Bridge. You can take pictures, learn about its history, walk across the walkway and enjoy the amazing views of the city. You might even see some boats passing by!
