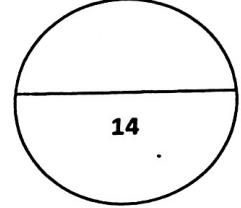

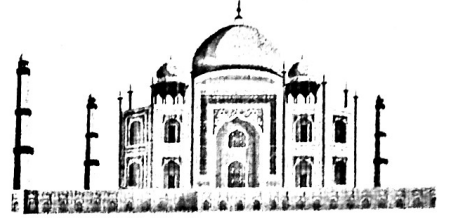

Taj Mahal is a famous tomb in Agra, India. It is one of the most beautiful buildings in the world. It was built by Emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his wife, Mumtaz Mahal, who died in 1631. The construction of Taj Mahal started in 1632 and was finished by 1643. The gardens and other buildings around it were completed by 1653.



The Taj Mahal is made of white marble and stands on the southern bank of the Yamuna River. It has four identical sides, each with a tall central arch that is 33 metres high. A big, round dome, over 73 metres tall, rises in the centre, with four smaller domes around it. The building is raised on a square platform with a tall tower at each corner.

Visitors enter through a large red sandstone gate decorated with writings from the Holy Qur'an. Behind the gate is a huge, carefully designed garden that is 305 metres wide on each side. The garden has a pool in the centre and water canals divide the garden into four parts. Each part of it has flower beds, fountains, and tall cypress trees.

Inside the Taj Mahal, the tomb of Mumtaz Mahal is at the centre of an eight-sided hall. The tomb of Shah Jahan, who died in 1666, is next to hers. Both tombs are beautifully decorated with colourful stones. Sunlight shines through a marble screen, making the inside of the tomb glow softly.

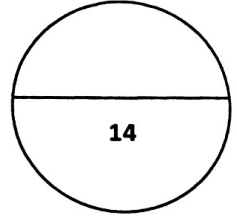
