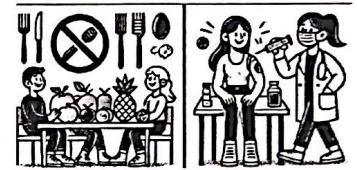
### B. Writing (16 Marks)
